SAN DIEGO CITY LIGHTS NIGHT TOUR

Witness unique sightseeing opportunities including Petco Park, The Embarcadero, the USS Midway, Naval Station North Island, the Silver Strand, the Convention Center, the Coronado Bridge and Glorietta Bay all from the deck of your super stable sit-on-top kayak. Choose between single, double and triple kayaks. Kayaks, paddles, life vests and paddle lesson are all included in the tour.



LA JOLLA COMBO TOUR

Duration: 2.5 Hours

Enjoy two of San Diego's most popular activities all in one fun tour! All the benefits of the La Jolla Kayak Tour PLUS a snorkeling adventure. Say hello to your friends the garibaldi, leopard sharks (no shark repellent necessary...leopard sharks are harmless!), rockfish, sea lions, spiny lobster, rays, shovelnose guitarfish and other marine creature in La Jolla Ecological Reserve. The Kayak & Snorkel Tour includes a wetsuit, mask, snorkel, fins, all the kayaking equipment and high-fives. Please note, snorkeling tours take place March through October. However, depending on ocean temperature in the off season, snorkeling tours can be reviewed on an individual basis.

SUNSET KAYAK LA JOLLA

It's been said that you have fully experienced California when you've seen one of the famed California Sunsets. What better way to soak up the view than with a front row seat on the water in a kayak? You'll paddle along the La Jolla Kayak Tour with the water nearly all to yourself, as sunny afternoon skies burst into vivid color. Finally, watch from the boat launch as the sun sets into the horizon and a feeling of relaxation washes over you. This is what a vacation is supposed to feel like.

LEOPARD SHARK SNORKELING ENCOUNTER

Duration: 2 Hours

Never snorkeled before? The gentle leopard sharks won't mind, and neither do we! The Leopard Shark Encounter is a 50-minute snorkeling lesson and opportunity to swim with harmless leopard sharks. We'll fit you with a wetsuit, fins, mask and snorkel. Your expert snorkel guide will teach you the snorkeling basics on dry land, and then you'll swim with the magnificent leopard sharks in the sandy flats of La Jolla Shores. Look for shovelnose guitarfish and stingrays too. After the tour, you may keep the snorkeling gear and wetsuit to play in the ocean for the rest of the day. Please note, snorkeling tours take place March through October. However, depending on ocean temperature in the off season, snorkeling tours can be reviewed on an individual basis.



WHALE AND DOLPHIN WATCHING TOUR

Duration: 4 Hours

If you love whales, dolphins, sea lions, and sea birds, hop on board for a breathtaking experience on the open ocean. We'll speed out to sea on one of our large, comfortable yachts and pass barking sea lions and pods of leaping dolphins as we search for the legendary blue whales-known for being the largest mammals on Earth. As we make our way on a 4-hour tour, we'll be treated to a live narration by our experienced captain and our on-board naturalist (from the San Diego Natural History Museum). You'll stay cozy and comfortable with both indoor and outdoor seating and a snack bar featuring hot food, a full bar, and souvenirs.

WHALE WATCHING KAYAK TOUR

Duration: 2-3 Hours

Beginning in December, thousands of Gray Whales migrate South from Alaska to the warmer water of Baja California, creating one of our most EXCITING adventures available! As these gentle giants migrate down our coast, your naturalist guide will lead you roughly 2 miles out in search of any biological hotspots, or "bait balls", that attract many types of sea birds, dolphin, sea lions, seals, and, of course, Gray Whales! The advantage to encountering these magnificent creatures aboard our kayaking ecotour is the quiet, intimate nature of not only being able experience them at eye level, but also to have the opportunity to hear each spout without the distracting noise of a boat engine. The Whale Watch Kayak Tour is available December through late February (weather permitting) and the price includes your kayak, paddle, Personal Floatation Device (PFD), helmet, and tour guide.

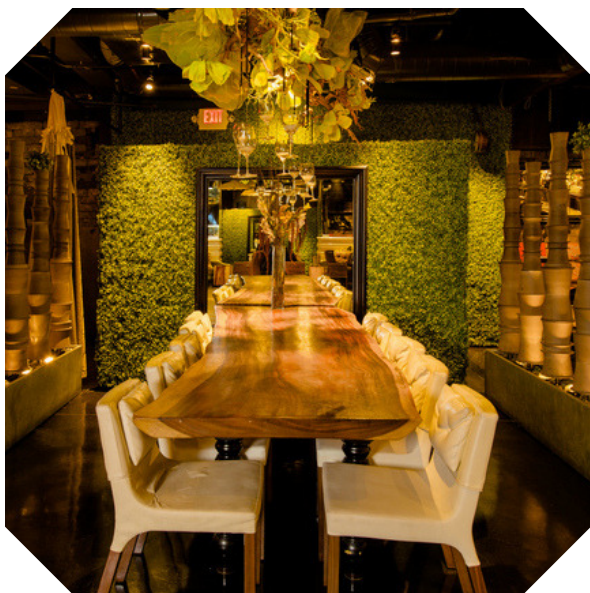
GEORGES OCEAN TERRACE

BICE

The network of Bice restaurants spanning the world today began 90 years ago in Milano, Italy by Beatrice Ruggeri – also known as Bice. She was the first child of a family of 10, and so had to help her parents raise her young siblings almost as they were her own. They lived on a farm where all had to work on the land and help with all chores, so she learned a lot of things that would help her create her future. For years she was encouraged to open her "cucina" to the public as she was known for her extraordinary hospitality and personal warmth, and in 1926, when her husband Gino asked her to move to America with him where he had previously been to make good money, she decided that she would rather try a city like Milano so that she could stay close to her family. They agreed to open a "trattoria" – loosely translated as a friendly gathering place with a farm to table approach. With Bice in the kitchen and her brothers and sisters serving in the dining room, il ristorante "Da Gino e Bice", or Bice as it would later be known, had a family feeling. The first customers said it was like being at the home of a friend, as Bice hoped they would.

The USS Midway was America's longest-serving aircraft carrier of the 20th century, from 1945 to 1992. Approximately 200,000 sailors served aboard the carrier, known for several naval aviation breakthroughs as well as several humanitarian missions. It was the only carrier to serve the entire length of the Cold War and beyond. It is now berthed in San Diego, the original home of the Navy's TOPGUN fighter school.

Midway opened as a museum on 7 June 2004. By 2012 annual visitation exceeded 1 million visitors. As of 2015 Midway is the most popular naval warship museum in the United States. The museum has over 13,000 members, and hosts more than 700 events a year, including more than 400 active-duty Navy retirements, re-enlistments, and changes of command. Events can take place on Hanger 1 & 2 along with the Flight Deck.
