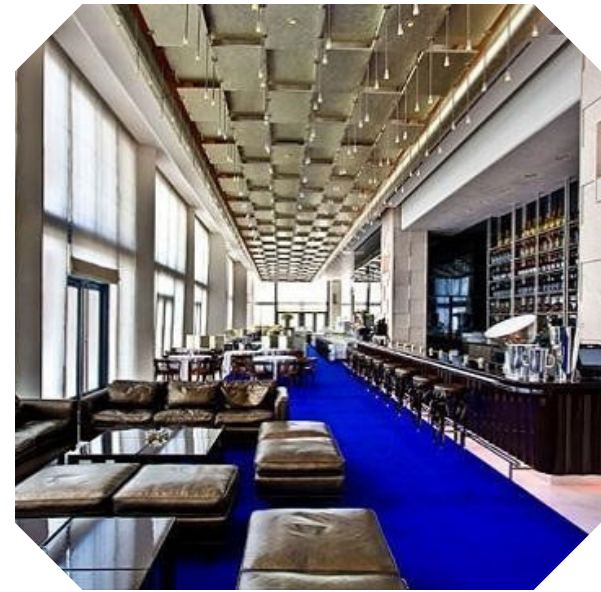


CASA TUA

MR. CHOWS

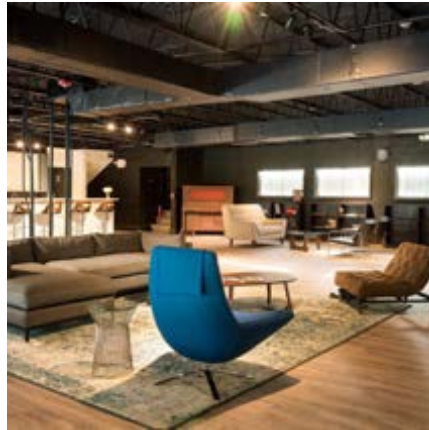
